City Plans, Especially Traffic

Mayor Nirenberg, Former Mayor Henry Cisneros, and others discussed San Antonio's future Plans a recent Northeast Neighborhood Alliance meeting at the City Tool Yard on Wuzback Parkway

Future Transportation

- The biggest concern was what gridlock was going to look like in the near future. Studies have shown that vehicle hours waiting in gridlock will increase 900% from 2010 to 2040. A plan was outlined that has some real possible solutions to it.
- They stated that most of the cities who had installed light rail to solve this problem, have had dismal results, costing those cities that installed light rail, finding them financial failures with very low ridership.
- The main concern for our District 10 is 1604 and I-35. Clayton Perry has been appointed to Texas State Committee and should be able to bring us at least our fair share of State dollars. \$100 million of the City Budget is earmarked for streets, stop signs, etc.
- They are currently already operating a part of the plan in District 10. You may have noticed pick ups and drop offs at VIA Hubs. This new application will streamline the process with many more options for riders to get to destinations. There will be several Main VIA routes with adjoining small lift options earmarked for final destinations. You also might have noticed "LINK" on the bus signs. This is the start of this program. To find out more about this program, call VIA LINK 210-455-5465.
- There will also be better street lights and synchronization.
- There will be an upcoming Bond issue for \$900 million, mostly for transportation.
- Public Safety is 2/3rds of the budget, which means more police are on the way.
